

## **AMENDMENTS TO MOTIONS**

Further to the Notice of Proposed Motions and Constitutional Amendments AGM 02/2021, amendments received by the closing date of 12 noon on Thursday 30th September are set out below.

### **1. Amendment to Motion 15: Complaints Policy and Procedure**

In paragraph 2, replace:

“We call upon the AGM to instruct the NEC to oversee a revision of the Disciplinary rules with reference to raising complaints and settling internal disputes.”

With:

“We call upon the AGM to instruct the NEC to draw up a complaints process to deal with internal disputes and external complaints and to revise the Disciplinary rules.”

### **2. Amendment to Motion 24: Time to Learn – Time for Training**

In Paragraph 5, replace the whole of the paragraph with:

“We must act now to transform the Probation Service into the quality service we know it can be using all the tools at our disposal.

This AGM instructs the Campaign Network alongside the Professional and Training Network to launch a campaign for the following:

- Quality time for professional development (with workload relief) for all staff
- Training and development opportunities to be delivered in a variety of ways, to respect and support different learning styles **and is inclusive**
- Creation of time and space (with workload relief) for practitioners to reflect on their work, both to enable better quality service delivery and also to protect practitioners from burnout

The campaign should also inform the consultations and negotiations that Officers and Officials have with the Probation Service.”
