

Timings

This is the second of the new format two-day AGMs but we have changed the timings in response to feedback from members at last year's AGM in Nottingham. Thanks to all those who responded to the survey this was of huge value.

This year conference will kick off at 10am on both the Friday and Saturday, with registration and refreshments from 9.00am. We will then run through until lunch at 12.30pm. We will finish at 5.45pm on the Friday, with optional fringe meetings in the early evening, and have an early finish at 3.00pm on the Saturday, to allow people to get back home at a reasonable time. There will also be fringe meetings on the Friday lunchtime this year and networking meetings on the Saturday lunchtime.

On Friday afternoon conference will split into a Family Court and a Probation Professional Session from 2.00pm until 3.30pm.

We will also have a large number and range of exhibitors and stalls from campaigning groups, member service providers and other research and information organisations, as well as Napo's national committees.

Debate and Discussion

As usual AGM will discuss and vote on a wide range of motions from members and branches. Motions to be considered by the AGM may be submitted by the NEC, a national committee, a Probation Branch, the Family Court Section, the PSO Forum or any two full or professional associate members of Napo. Constitutional amendments may be submitted only by the NEC this year. Motions should be submitted on the form provided which is available from Annoesjka Valent (avalent@napo.org.uk - 020 7223 4887) at the Napo office. Motions must reach the General Secretary no later than 12 noon on Friday 10th August. Amendments to motions and amendments to constitutional amendments must reach the General Secretary by 12 noon on Friday 21st September. Details of motions and constitutional amendments received will be circulated to members at the end of August.
