In order to make a noise about the chaos in Probation however, we need as many members as possible to attend. The lobby is focusing on voices from the frontline and a number of members have offered to speak at the lobby to tell their experiences of working in probation chaos. We are hopeful that members will offer contributions from the floor as well so there will be plenty of opportunity for you to have your say. Branches will be meeting at the Monument opposite Parliament at 12.30 with a view to joining the queue at 1pm.
